Activities

Our classes are broken down into three main activities, Acting, Singing and Dance, In addition, we will look at a wide variety of performing arts subjects, such as;

- Directing
- Camera skills
- Improvisation
- Editing
- Special Effects Makeup

We will also be looking to bring in industry performers to run workshops with the students i.e. a west end workshop, film workshop, headshots workshops etc.

Our aim through the classes is to inspire confidence through the activities, for our students to take leadership and develop their skills.

We will aim to put on a showcase or show at the end of each term. We will also work to create short films and projects.

Child safety

Clothes

The students are required to wear all black. Howell School of Acting t-shirts may be provided to the students depending on the class, these are to be worn each week. Leggings, shorts or joggers are suitable, jeans are not.

Shoe wise we ask that the students wear comfortable, secure shoes suitable for dancing in.

Acting Camps

Our Holiday Acting Camps are usually held in a secured forest area and are primarily outdoors (barring our Christmas Camp).

Our camps last 1 week and are 8.30am-4pm. We either create a film which will then have a film premiere or we perform the show at the end of the week.





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Water and Snacks

Water bottles are vital as the classes will be very physical. Due to coronavirus all water bottles must be clearly marked with the student's name.

Students may bring a snack which can be eaten during breaks. Sharing food is now prohibited due to coronavirus

Medication

If your child requires any medication or has any health concerns please ensure you inform Emi Howell prior to the beginning of the term.

No medication will be provided by Howell School of Acting and any medication they bring themselves cannot be shared with other students. All medication must be clearly labelled.

Due to Covid-19, we are putting measures in place to ensure everyone stays safe. You will need to inform Howell School of Acting before the term begins if your child or anyone in close contact with your child has been abroad, suffered from Coronavirus or displays coronavirus symptoms. If your child does develop flu-like symptoms, or anyone in close contact with them does, Howell School of Acting will need to be informed and steps will need to be taken that may include not attending the class.
